

Cheviot Recycles!

Did you know that 60% of materials that end up in the landfill could have been recycled? By recycling, you help save energy, preserve natural resources, conserve landfill space and help the economy. Start recycling today!

Cheviot offers three convenient Recycling Drop-Offs:

- Cheviot Maintenance Garage, 3729 Robb Avenue
- Cheviot Municipal Parking Lot, 3719 Harrison Avenue
- Old IGA (behind the building), 3970 North Bend Road



The bright green and yellow containers are for paper and the dark green are for all other recyclables.

Acceptable Items Include:

- All plastic bottles, no lids
- Glass jars and bottles of any color
- Aluminum, steel and empty aerosol cans with lids and tips removed
- Paper bags, envelopes with or without windows, junk mail, computer paper and other mixed office paper, magazines, telephone books and newspapers with inserts
- Paperboard, such as cereal boxes
- Corrugated cardboard, broken down to 3' x 3'
- Pizza boxes with all grease and food residue removed

*Please rinse out all containers.
You do NOT have to remove labels.*

Unacceptable Items Include:

- Plastics that are not bottles, such as Cool Whip™ containers, butter tubs, or food trays
- Plastic bags
- Polystyrene foam, such as Styrofoam™
- Lids/caps
- Window or drinking glass and light bulbs
- Coat hangers or steel scrap
- Motor oil jugs, paint cans, or other chemical containers

You can also drop off paper only at these locations:

- U.S. Post Office, 3336 Harrison Avenue
- Cheviot United Methodist Church, 3820 Westwood Northern Boulevard
- Cheviot School, 4040 Harrison Avenue
- St. Martin School, 3720 St. Martins Place
