ORDINANCE NO. 14 - 7

TO AMEND THE 2014 ANNUAL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS; TO TRANSFER FUNDS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2014, by Ordinance No. 14-1, this council set the city's budget appropriations for the first quarter of 2014; and

WHEREAS, due to certain unforeseen revenues and expenses, it has now become necessary to amend the previously enacted appropriations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:


Section 1. The following budget line items shall be increased by the amounts indicated:

707.111.262.1	JEDD-Mercy Long-term Maintenance	48.50
101.714.212.2	Workers Compensation	52,500.00

This will bring the new total appropriation for the above line items to \$48.50 and \$54,000.00, respectively.

Section 2. The sum of \$4,000.00 shall be transferred from the General Contingency Fund (Fund No. 101) to the Waste Collection Services Fund (Fund No. 503) in order to pay recycling expenses.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order ~~to allow the city~~ to allow the city to meet its financial obligations in a timely manner.
