ORDINANCE NO. 15 – 16

**TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO 95-52; TO DEFINE THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR'S SECRETARY; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, on December 5, 1995, the council of the City of Cheviot passed Ordinance No. 95-52, which granted additional compensation to the Mayor's secretary for assuming the duties of the recreation commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, since the passage of Ordinance No. 95-52, the recreation administration duties have become a routine part of the Mayor's secretary's job function, and no additional compensation is considered to be warranted; and

**WHEREAS**, the city council desires to set the compensation of the Mayor's secretary at a base level which does not include a supplemental payment for recreation administration duties;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:**

Section 1. Ordinance No. 95-52, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Mayor's secretary shall be paid at a base rate of compensation, as set by this council, which does not include a bonus or supplement for the performance of recreation administration duties. The recreation administration duties shall continue to remain a part of the Mayor's secretary's job responsibilities. However, there will be no additional compensation for the work.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the City of Cheviot to fairly compensate its employees at the earliest possible time.

ORDINANCE INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE SECRETARY OF THE MAYOR  
FOR THE DUTIES OF THE RECREATION COMMISSION  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the duties of the recreation secretary are being handled by the secretary to the mayor, and

WHEREAS, these are duties in addition to her job assignments from the Mayor and the Safety Service Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF CHEVIOT, OHIO :

SECTION 1. The salary of the secretary of the Mayor is hereby increased an additional \$1,661.20 dollars per year. This portion of the secretary of the mayor's shall be paid out of budget line item 101.301.211.1 CHEVIOT FIELDHOUSE (REC) SALARIES.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be retroactive to March 1, 1995, when the secretary to the mayor began these additional duties. Therefore, the city auditor is instructed to issue a back pay check, less normal deductions, in the amount of \$1,392.82.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cheviot. The reason for said emergency is to allow this Ordinance to take effect at the earliest time under the law of the State of Ohio and the City of Cheviot.
