RESOLUTION NO. 14 – 5

TO SUBMIT TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS A PROPOSED RENEWAL TAX LEVY TO BE VOTED UPON BY THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT AT THE MAY 6, 2014, PRIMARY ELECTION; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this council to place before the electors of the City of Cheviot the renewal of a 5.61 mill tax levy to be voted upon at the May 6, 2014, primary election; and

WHEREAS, the proposed levy renewal is necessary for the operation of the city and is in excess of the ten-mill limitation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Cheviot has submitted the renewal of the 5.61 mill levy to the Hamilton County Auditor for certification; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2014 the Hamilton County Auditor issued a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1. Pursuant to Sections 5705.03, 5705.19, 5705.191, 5705.192, and 5705.25 of the Ohio Revised Code, this council requests that the Hamilton County Board of Elections take the steps necessary to place on the ballot at the May 6, 2014, primary election the following proposed tax levy:


- A. Type of Levy. The levy shall be a renewal tax levy authorized by Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code.
- B. Purpose of Levy. The purpose of the proposed 5.61 mill levy is to provide funds for the current expenses of the city.
- C. Proposed Millage Rate. The levy shall be set at the rate of 5.61 mills.

D. Calendar Year in Which Levy is Due. The levy shall first become due in calendar year 2015.

E. Term of Levy. The levy shall be for a term of five years.


Section 2. Upon passage of this resolution, the Clerk of Council shall immediately certify a copy of it to the Hamilton County Board of Elections along with the Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue, which has been provided by the Hamilton County Auditor.


Section 3. This resolution shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the city to comply with the time requirements of Chapter 5705 of the Ohio Revised Code so that the proposed tax levy may appear on the ballot of the May 6, 2014, primary election.




