RESOLUTION NO. 16 - 22

TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO RENEGOTIATE CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE CHEVIOT PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTERS.

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2016, by Resolution No. 16-17, this council approved a new three year collective bargaining agreement with the Cheviot Professional Firefighters; and

WHEREAS, that agreement became effective on June 1, 2016, and will remain in effect through May 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, both parties to the agreement now wish to reopen the agreement to clarify certain issues with regard to testing and promotion through the civil service system; and


WHEREAS, the changes will have no monetary impact to the City of Cheviot, but will clarify the procedures for the implementation of the existing contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to reopen the collective bargaining agreement with the Cheviot Professional Firefighters for the purpose of clarifying the testing procedures for promotion of all ranks, a promotion to the position of Lieutenant, and the subsequent promotion of a Lieutenant to the position of Captain when a vacancy occurs.

Section 2. Upon reaching an agreement with the union, the Mayor shall submit the proposed changes to this council for approval.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
