RESOLUTION NO. 16 - 28

TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF MONEYS FROM THE CRIMINAL ACTIVITY/FORFEITURE ACCOUNT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW POLICE CRUISER.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cheviot has previously established a Law Enforcement Trust Fund under Chapter 2981 of the Ohio Revised Code; and


WHEREAS, in its annual budget appropriation ordinance, this council has created a budget line item to correspond to the Law Enforcement Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2981.13(c)(2)(A)(v) of the Ohio Revised Code, expenditures from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund must be approved by the legislative authority and are limited to expenditures for law enforcement purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1. The expenditure of moneys from the criminal activity/forfeiture account (budget line item number 208.101.239.3) for the ~~partial~~ payment of the purchase price of a new police cruiser is hereby approved. Any money from the account not used toward the purchase of the vehicle shall remain in the account.


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.






