Upon review and discussion, the committee agreed that the ordinance needs to be slightly revised to include:

Food trucks need to be inspected yearly and as part of the application process by the Cheviot Fire Department

Mention needs to be made that all other city ordinances are in still in effect, i.e.: feeding the parking meter, noise level.

Include a basic background check, to be performed by the Cheviot Police Department, as part of the application process.

There were a few other areas of concern, but as those present read through the ordinance, we found those concerns to be addressed.

Due to the interest from the public regarding having a food truck in Cheviot and the amount of time it has taken to draft the ordinance, we feel the need to declare an emergency to pass the ordinance.



The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.


