RE: Finance Committee Meeting

To All Members of Council:


The Finance Committee met on March 31, 2015 at 8:10pm in the meeting room of the city building following the Cheviot Family Day planning/assignment meeting. In attendance were committee members: Jim Martin, Leslie Roden, Jim Sunderhaus and committee chair Dennis Dinkelacker. Also in attendance were Council Members: Bill Clark, Amy Richter and Kitty Zech, Safety Service Director Tom Braun, Police Chief Joe Lally, and Fire Chief Bob Klein.

The focus of this meeting is to discuss the part-time pool employee wage increases, part-time fireman's wage increases, and part-time police officer wage increases. Chairman Dinkelacker informed the committee and others that we would go through the part-time pool employee's first, since the SSD had prior obligations. Mr. Braun informed the committee and others of the current salaries of life guards, assistant pool manager and the pool manager. LG-minimum wage (\$8.10), APM-\$9.50 an hour, and PM-\$10.50 an hour. Chairman Dinkelacker proposed increasing the LG salary to \$9.00, APM \$10.50, and PM \$11.50 an hour, and the City of Cheviot paying a maximum of \$200.00 towards their certification. Another scenario was LG-\$9.50, APM-\$11.00, and PM-\$12.00 an hour, and the city not reimbursing them for their certification. The committee and others were in agreement of the first option.

The second topic of discussion is pertaining to the part-time fireman's wage increases. The Police & Fire Chairman (Mr. Sunderhaus) had an outline of the proposed increases at last week's Police & Fire committee meeting. After discussion with Chief Klein and some minor adjustments to various sections, it was agreed upon by the committee and others to accept the part-time wage increases.


