Division of Fire Report
December 2015

Members of Council,

During the first eleven months of 2015 the Fire Department responded to 1102 EMS runs and 342 fire runs. Our Fire Inspectors completed 208 fire inspections. Thirty five fire prevention actives were held at the station including educating our locals schools, preschools and fire training for Oak Hills Pavilion. The department installed 64 car seats and trained 990 hours in fire and EMS. Fire hydrant monthly winter service began in October we maintain 247 hydrants that are greased, lubed, and cleared of ice and snow every 3-4 weeks through April. Hydrant painting will begin in April.

The Hamilton County radio was backordered and was installed in the 2016 Ford explorer in early October and the graphics will be done by the end of year per plan. As of November 18th it has been used for hydrant service and additional responses.

Heroin overdoses are on the rise, most of the people do not live in Cheviot. Treatment packets are given in all cases. The Hamilton County Sheriff has formed a Heroin task force.

The Fire Department maintains all of our own vehicles and equipment. Weekly checks are done on all vehicles, breathing apparatus, saws, smoke ejectors, and extrication equipment. Daily checks are done on both squads, and fire apparatus. The personnel clean and disinfect the firehouse daily. The fire department also maintains the fuel log for city hall and measures the fuel levels daily.
