Division of Fire Monthly Report
Jan-May 2015

Members of Council,

During the period January-May the Fire Department responded to 506 EMS runs and 141 fire runs. Our Fire Inspectors completed 120 fire inspections. 14 fire prevention tours were held at the station and 3 off site events were attended. The department installed 31 car seats and trained 450 hours in fire and EMS. Fire hydrants were checked and cleared of ice and snow and serviced. The new truck will be placed in service on by 7/1/5. Training and equipment mounting will occur over the next two weeks.

We have addressed the heroin epidemic by giving out the resource packets other local departments have been using. The police and fire department were involved in a 3 day joint active shooter program training at Oak Hills High School, our Cheviot guys proved to be outstanding under pressure, and highly skilled in their disciplines.

The Fire Department maintains all of our own vehicles and equipment. Weekly checks are done on all vehicles, breathing apparatus, saws, smoke ejectors, and extrication equipment. Daily checks are done on both squads, and fire apparatus. The personnel clean and disinfect the firehouse daily. The fire department also maintains the fuel log for city hall and measures the fuel levels daily.
