Re: Police Department Activity Report

During the first Quarter of 2016, our Police Department activity included:

- Nine (9) Felony arrests, including:
 - A subject arrested for a Burglary that occurred on Trevor Avenue (via fingerprints);
 - Subjects arrested for Drug possession;
 - A subject arrested for breaking into vehicles at Hader Roofing; and
 - A suspect was arrested and indicted on the Craig's List robbery.
- Eighty (80) Misdemeanor arrests, which included:
 - Multiple subjects arrested on drug charges, including those related to overdoses;
 - Forty-one subjects arrested for Failing To Appear in Mayor's Court; and
 - Several subjects arrested for Domestic Violence and unrelated Assault charges.
- One-hundred, sixty-five (165) Traffic charges, including:
 - Forty-five (45) arrests for Driving Under Suspension;
 - Sixty-nine (69) cited for Speeding; and
 - Seven (7) arrested for OVI.
- Seventy-six (76) arrests of subjects who had outstanding warrants from other Jurisdictions, including six (6) Felony warrants.

Miscellaneous Information:

- With the assignments Officers Dietrich & Ehler to investigative positions, we were in need of a new Field Training Instructor. In response to that need **Officer Linnig** completed his instructor training, and is ready to provide the necessary direction to potential police officer candidates;
- **Sergeant Stone** and **Officer Dietrich** attended Explosive Recognition training;
- **Sergeant Stone** and **Investigators Ehler & Uhl** attended an Organized Retail Crime seminar;
- All of our officers completed State mandated training, including the topics of Human Trafficking and Domestic Violence;
- We were recognized by the Countywide OVI Task Force for a significant increase in OVI arrests (year-over-year) for the period running from October 2015 – March 2016.
