Re: Police Department Activity Report

During the fourth Quarter of 2014, our Police Department activity included:

- Twelve (12) Felony arrests, including:
 - The 5/3rd Bank robbery suspect being indicted;
 - A seventeen year old was arrested for felonious assault against an infant;
 - Two suspects were identified from the UDF robbery;
 - Several subjects apprehended for breaking into vacant properties; and
 - A suspect was arrested and indicted on the Craig's List robbery.
- Ninety (90) Misdemeanor arrests, which included:
 - Several subjects arrested for vehicle tampering / theft;
 - Multiple subjects arrested for drug possession; and
 - Subjects arrested for Domestic Violence and related charges.
- One-hundred, thirty-two (132) Traffic charges, including:
 - Thirty-four (34) arrests for Driving Under Suspension;
 - Twenty-six (26) cited for Speeding; and
 - Five (5) arrested for OVI.
- Seventy-six (76) arrests of subjects who had outstanding warrants from other Jurisdictions, including 6 Felony warrants.

Training included:

- **Officers Goff & Linnig** attended advanced training related to building searches & crimes in progress.
- **Officer Goff** administered in-service recertification for **all officers** for Taser use.
- Department training was held on the topics of First Aid and Bloodborne Pathogens, with a presentation on Response to Hold-up Alarms. **Mr. Waters** also briefed everyone on the effect of a recent Ohio Supreme Court decision on the filing of Warrants.
