Re: Police Department Activity Report

During January of 2016, our Police Department activity included:

- Four (4) Felony arrests, which included:
  - A subject who was arrested for a Burglary on Trevor Avenue (via fingerprints);
  - A subject who was arrested for drug felony Drug possession (heroin); and
  - Two subjects arrested for Check fraud.
- Twenty-one (21) Misdemeanor arrests, which included:
  - Several subjects for drug (and related) charges;
  - Several subjects arrested for crimes of violence, including Assault, and Domestic Violence
- Fifty-nine (59) Traffic charges, including:
  - Two (2) arrests for Operation a Vehicle under the Influence of alcohol / drugs;
  - Eleven (11) arrests for Driving Under Suspension; and
  - Twenty-seven (27) cited for Speeding.
- Twenty-four (24) arrests of subjects who had outstanding warrants from other Jurisdictions, including one on a Felony warrant.

Points of interest:

- The Bargaining Unit voted (in November) to go back to rotating shifts. This change took effect January 1<sup>st</sup>, and will involve officers changing shifts every three (3) months.
- Our representative to the **Regional Enforcement of Narcotics Unit** has changed.
- We have hired three new officers: **Officer Ryan Wagoner** was promoted to a full-time position, and **Officers Chris Climer** and **Matt Kane** recently completed Field Training, and are working part-time.
- **Officer Scott Ehler** has begun working with **Officer Bob Uhl** on investigations. This will allow Officer Ehler to take over investigations in a full-time capacity, and Officer Uhl to pare back his duties. Officer Uhl will be staying with the Department in a part-time, as well as an advisory capacity.
