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Meeting was called to order at 7:30 by President Slaughter with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer. The following were found to be in attendance:

There were reports from the Police and Fire Departments. Since the reports are lengthy, the Clerk advised that she has the reports on file and they will be available for public viewing.

Mr. Clark presented his report of the Community Events Committee held on 1/26. He motioned to receive and file. Motion was seconded by Mr. Sunderhaus.

Mrs. Richter's report from the Public Relations Committee meeting held on 1/26 was read by Mr. Tiettmeyer. There was a motion to receive and file, seconded by Mr. Dinkelacker.

Ordinance 16-2 To Implement Sections 3735.65 Through 3735.70 Of The Ohio Revised Code, Establishing And Describing The Boundaries Of The Residential Community Reinvestment Area In The City of Cheviot, Designating A Housing Officer To Administer The Program, And Creating A Community Reinvestment Housing Council; And To Declare An Emergency. Mr. Martin read by title. This constitutes the third reading. The ordinance is adopted with a 6-0 roll call vote.

Resolution 16-6 To Transfer Certain Funds (Auto Equipment Fund to pay for dump truck & accessories; Auto Equipment Fund to pay principal and interest on firetruck; Energy Efficiency Fund for payment on loan)

Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller and Mr. Braun will be attending a meeting with the Kiwanis to discuss this year's Harvest Home Fair. Next week he and Mr. Braun and Mrs. Statkus will be meeting with the new directors of Cheviot Savings Bank. No date is set to meet with the FOP representative to discuss wage negotiations.

Safety Service Director: Mr. Braun asked council to inform the citizenry to be wary of telemarketers who are trying to lure people away from the City's utility aggregation programs. Council will need to vote on the annual appropriations on March 22.

Law Director: Mr. Waters had no report.

Public Recognition: Irene Vitalkis came to talk about two upcoming events, Cuffs and Ladders, an (April 23) and Honor Run.


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
