Introduced by Mr. Baker, with a second by Mrs. Zech. Motion to adopt carried with a 7-0 voice vote.

Clerk reports that Fred Spurling submitted a building permit report.

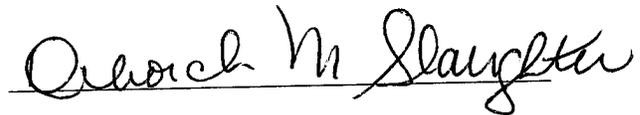
