Minutes of City Council, Cheviot, Ohio

In Mayor Keller's absence, President of Council Deborah M. Slaughter acted as Mayor, and Kitty Zech assumed the role of President of Council, Pro Tem. Mrs. Zech called the meeting to order at 7:30 with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer. The following were found to be in attendance:

There was a motion made by Mr. Martin and seconded by Mr. Clark to excuse Mr. Sunderhaus' absence. Mrs. Richter was not present at roll call, but arrived later, in time to vote on this evening's legislation.

A motion to approve the minutes of the March 1 meeting was made by Mr. Dinkelacker, seconded by Mr. Clark.

Mr. Dinkelacker read into record his report from the Finance Committee meeting held on March 8. Motion to receive and file was made by Mr. Dinkelacker, seconded by Mr. Clark. Motion carried with a 5-0 voice vote.

Two pieces of legislation were presented to council.

Res. 16-9 To Transfer Funds For The City's Share Of Police And Fire Pension And Disability Expenses. Resolution was introduced by Mr. Dinkelacker, seconded by Mr. Martin and approved by council via a 6-0 voice vote.

Ord. 16-4 Annual Appropriations Ordinance For Calendar Year 2016, Ending December 31, 2016. Introduced by Mr. Dinkelacker, second by Mr. Tiettmeyer. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Martin, second by Mrs. Richter. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Clark, second by Mr. Martin. All motions carried by unanimous vote by council.




The regular meeting resumed at 8:38. Mrs. Slaughter stated that she is attending Much In Common on 3/31 and asked if any other council members planned to attend.
