Mayor's Court Receipts for March 2016. Motion to receive and file made by Mrs. Zech, second by Mr. Tiettmeyer.

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
Clerk reminded all elected officials that Financial Disclosures are due before Monday, May 16, 2016.


Building and Zoning Reports received for the months of March and April. These reports will be posted to the website for public view.
