Motion to adopt made by Mr. Martin, second by Mr. Dinkelacker. Motion carried with a 6-0 roll call vote.

Ordinance 15-12 To Increase The wage Rates Of The Part-Time Police Officers In The City Of Cheviot; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Richter. Motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mr. Richter. Motion to suspend carried with a 6-0 roll call vote. Motion to adopt was made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Richter. Motion carried with a 6-0 roll call vote.

Ordinance 15-13 To Establish Certain Wages, Benefits, And Working Conditions Of Part Time Fire Personnel; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Zech. Motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote. Motion to suspend the rules was made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Richter. Motion carried with a 6-0 roll call vote. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Dinkelacker, second by Mrs. Richter, and carried with a 6-0 roll call vote.

Ordinance 15-14 To Authorize Pay Raises For Certain Full Time Employees; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce made by Mr. Dinkelacker, second by Mr. Sunderhaus. Motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mrs. Zech, second by Mrs. Roden. Carried with a 6-0 roll call vote. Motion to adopt made by Mrs. Zech, second by Mrs. Richter, carried with a 5-0 roll call vote; Mr. Sunderhaus abstained.

Resolution 15-8 To Authorize The Safety-Service Director To Solicit Bids For The Renovation Of The Municipal Swimming Pool; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce made by Mr. Martin, second by Mr. Sunderhaus. Resolution adopted with a 6-0 voice vote.

Mr. Dinkelacker presented his report from the Finance Committee's meetings held on February 24. Mr. Dinkelacker motioned to receive and file. Mrs. Richter seconded the motion, and it carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Mr. Dinkelacker presented his report from the Finance Committee meeting held on March 3. Motion to receive and file was made by Mr. Dinkelacker, seconded by Mrs. Richter. Following President Slaughter's request that she be added to those in attendance on the reports of all the meetings, the motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Mr. Dinkelacker presented his report from the Finance Committee meeting of March 10. Motion to receive and file was made by Mr. Dinkelacker, seconded by Mr. Sunderhaus, and motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Mr. Dinkelacker presented his report of the Finance Committee meeting held on March 31. Motion was made by Mr. Dinkelacker to receive and file, motion seconded by Mrs. Richter, and carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Mr. Sunderhaus presented his report from the Police and Fire Committee meeting from March 10. Mr. Sunderhaus continued with his report of the continuation of that meeting held on March 17. Meeting continued on March 24. Mr. Sunderhaus read the report of that meeting. Motion to receive and file was made by Mr. Sunderhaus, seconded by Mrs. Richter and carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Safety Service Director's Report: Firetruck finance is done. The firetruck is in transit. Natureworks equipment should be in place for Cheviot Family Day. Mrs. Statkus created a newsletter, which will be mailed with the next water bill. Robb Ave construction will resume as soon as the weather breaks.

Ohio Liquor Board reminds that licenses are up for renewal. Further discussion at next meeting.


