

MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL MEETING, CHEVIOT, OHIO

April 20, 2004

The regular session of Council was called to order at 7:35 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of prayer. Roll call was taken and the following were found in attendance:

Mr. Mestemaker made a motion to excuse Mrs. Gooch. Mr. Dinkelacker made the second. The motion passed 6-0 by voice vote. The minutes of April 6, 2004 were approved. President Morganroth called for the reports that would be presented.

Recognition of the Public

No one wished to address Council.

Safety-Service Director's Report

Mr. Neal was not in attendance. A copy of the report that he forwarded to Council is on file.

Mayor's Report

Mayor Keller did not forward a report.

Law Director's Report

Mr. Waters informed Council that he was assisting the outside council for the case against the Cheviot Police.

Committee Reports

Ward 1 - Mr. Murray reported to Council about that the City Maintenance Department replaced the roof of the Grandstands at the main field at the Field House and that City Pool Passes go on sale on May 3.

Ward 2 - Mr. Dinkelacker had no formal report.

Ward 3 - Mr. Sunderhaus made a motion *To Object To The Renewal Of The Liquor Permits Of J.Z.J.N., Inc. (DBA Stewart's Irish Pub) For The Reasons Set Forth In Section 430.292(A) Of The Ohio Revised Code; And To Declare An Emergency.* The second was made by Mr. Mestemaker. The motion passed 6-0 by voice vote and was assigned as RES04-07. Mr. Sunderhaus also wanted to inform the public that the Cheviot-Westwood Kiwanis, the Cheviot Fire Association, the Cheviot Police Association, and the Cheviot Fire Department teamed up to provide bicycle helmets for \$10 to residents on Saturday, May 1, 2004 from 9:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M. The Police Department will also conduct a bicycle safety training course.

Ward 4 - Mrs. Gooch did not forward a report.

Council at Large - Mr. Mestemaker had no formal report. He did request that everyone keep Batavia resident, Matt Maupin in their prayers. Mr. Maupin is serving in Iraq and has been captured and held prisoner.

Council at Large - Mrs. Zech presented Council with the final reading of ORD04-13, *To Adopt Section 131.06 Of The Cheviot Code Of Ordinances, Which Restricts Dangerous Growth Of Vegetation In Or About The Public Right Of Way*. Mrs. Zech made a motion to adopt with a second from Mr. Murray. The motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote. Mrs. Zech also asked everyone to keep Matt Maupin and all the hostages in their prayers.

Council at Large - Mr. Norman presented Council with the final reading of ORD04-12, *To Adopt Section 151.08 Of The Cheviot Code Of Ordinances, Which Imposes The Obligation For The Payment Of Certain Engineering Fees Upon The Requesting Developer*. Mr. Norman made a motion to adopt with a second from Mr. Mestemaker. The motion passed 6-0 by roll call vote.

Further Business

Mr. Mestemaker made a motion to receive and file the March 2004 Treasurer's Report with a second from Mr. Sunderhaus. The motion passed 6-0 by voice vote.

Correspondence

There were four building department reports received. A copy was placed in each Council member's mailbox. An Ohio Municipal League bulletin was received. The requested list of liquor permit holders was received from the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control.

There was a motion to adjourn the meeting by Mrs. Zech with a second from Mr. Sunderhaus. The motion passed 6-0 by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
