Nemann Company For Work On The Cheviot 2012 Street Improvement Project; And To Declare An Emergency was introduced by Mr. Clark, seconded by Mr. Sunderhaus. Motion to suspend the rules was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Ms. Zech. Motion to adopt was made by Mr. Zech, seconded by Mr. Dinkelacker. Ordinance adopted with a 7-0 vote.

Resolution 12-12 Resolution Declaring Intent To Enter Into Shared Services Agreement With Other Political Subdivisions was introduced by Mr. Sunderhaus and seconded by Mr. Baker. Resolution was accepted with a 7-0 voice vote
