Meeting was called to order at 7:30 by President Slaughter with the Pledge of Allegiance and silent prayer. Roll was called, and the following were found to be in attendance:

A motion was made by Mr. Martin to excuse Mr. Baker's absence. Motion was seconded by Mrs. Richter and carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Minutes from the May 6th meeting were approved with a motion by Mr. Dinkelacker, a second by Mr. Sunderhaus and a unanimous aye vote.

Mrs. Zech presented her report from the Laws, Rules and Ordinances committee meeting held on 5/13. A motion to receive and file the report was made by Mrs. Zech, seconded by Mr. Dinkelacker

President Slaughter presented her report from the Public Utilities meeting held on May 13. Motion to receive and file was made by Mr. Sunderhaus, with a second by Mrs. Richter.

Ordinance 14-13 To Approve The Bid Submitted By The J. K. Muerer Company For The Resurfacing Of The Tennis Courts At The Cheviot Field house; And to Declare An Emergency. Introduced by Mr. Clark, with a second by Mr. Dinkelacker. Motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote. Motion to suspend the rules was made by Mr. Martin, with a second by Mrs. Zech. Motion carried with a 6-0 roll call vote. Motion to adopt was made by Mr. Clark, with a second by Mr. Sunderhaus. Motion to adopt carried with a 6-0 roll call vote.

Resolution 14-10 To Authorize And Direct The Safety Service Director To Solicit Bids For The Reconstruction Of Robb Avenue From Bridgetown Road To The South Corporation; And To Declare An Emergency. Introduced by Mr. Clark, with a second by Mr. Martin. Motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote. Section 1 amended to include West Court with a motion by Mr. Clark and a second by Mr. Sunderhaus.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller thanked President Slaughter for spearheading the Fiscal Sustainability Committee.

Safety-Service Director: Mr. Braun reported that the new JEDD with Green Township will include Harrison Green. Restaurants moving into that location (where WN Blvd meets Harrison Ave) will include Tom & Chee, Dewey's, Graeter's and First Watch. Hoping to tie in WN Blvd project with Harrison Green. Electric aggregation is on hold for now, although bids are still coming in. Pre-meeting for the tennis court resurfacing project will be next week. The Robb Ave repaving project will require re-routing of Metro bus routes. Life guards are needed for the Harvest Home Pool.

Law Director's Report: The Safety Service Director received the deed for the Morebattle Building. Working on legislation regarding vacant property and fences. Mr. Waters also offered clarification on the need for codification of ordinances.


