New playground equipment is in and will be installed at Harvest Home Park soon. 62 orders for grass cutting have been issued, 11 of those have been cut and will likely continue to be cut by city crew.

Law Director: Mr. Waters reports the the Drama Workshop easement will be executed tonight. Mr. Waters needs tax levy details to include in the resolution to repeal the old levy. A Police Department grievance is pending.


Public Recognition: Pat Van Fossen wanted to thank all of the city for the compassion and kindness shown to her and her sister, Nan.
