Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Richter. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Martin, second by Mr. Tiettmeyer.

Ordinance 16-10 Vacant Property Ordinance, introduced by title only by Mr. Martin with a second by Mrs. Richter. This constitutes the first reading of this ordinance.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller reminded everyone that our bicentennial celebration is a mere 18 months away. Would like one member of council to serve on the planning committee and to act as a liaison between that committee and administration.

Safety Services Director: Mr. Braun stated that sidewalk inspections in Ward 1 are complete. 81 pool passes have been sold to date.


Mayor's Court Receipts for the month of June were received and filed with a motion by Mrs. Zech and a second by Mrs. Richter.


There was one property maintenance violation report received.
