Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller had no formal report. Health insurance quote came in at 11.5% increase, with the ability to reduce by 3% by reducing the employed funded dental program. The net increase would be around 8%.

Law Director. : Tax Budget resolution (Res 15-13) was filed with the county. Arbitration set for Aug 27 at 10AM at City Hall. Mark preparing legislation for disposal of abandoned property. Currently working on court cost ordinance and food truck ordinance.
