Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Richter. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Dinkelacker, second by Mrs. Richter.

Mayor's Report: MainSource Bank has indicated that they are intending to use the former Cheviot Savings Bank building as a hub for their operations. The Fire Department will be holding a promotional exam. A newly created part time position will enable the Building Department to be open additional hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays..




Law Director: Mr. Waters reported that the Tax Ordinance and JEDD Ordinance were both delivered to the County Auditor's office.
