Meeting was called to order at 7:30PM by President Slaughter with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer. Roll was called and the following were found to be in attendance:

Mrs. Zech's absence was excused with a motion by Mr. Sunderhaus, a second by Mr. Martin and a unanimous voice vote.

Minutes from the August 19 meeting were approved with a motion by Mr. Clark, a second by Mr. Dinkelacker and a 5-0 voice vote..

Police Chief Lally presented a report from the Police Department for the month of August.

Mr. Baker read into record his report from the Buildings and Annexation Committee meeting of August 26. Mr. Baker motioned that the report be received and filed. Motion was seconded by Mr. Sunderhaus, and carried with a 5-0 voice vote.

Mr. Clark read into record his report from the Parks and Recreation Committee meeting held on August 26. Mr. Clark motioned to receive and file the report. Motion was seconded by Mr. Sunderhaus and carried with a 5-0 voice vote.

Mrs. Richter joined the meeting at 7:50.

Mr. Dinkelacker read into record his report from the Finance Committee meeting held on July 30. With one correction (Mr. Clark's attendance had not been recorded), Mr. Dinkelacker motioned to receive and file the report. Motion was seconded by Mr. Clark and carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Ordinance 14-22. To Adopt Amendments To The Codified Ordinances Of Cheviot As Published By American Legal Publishing Corporation; And To Declare An Emergency. Introduced by Mr. Baker with a second by Mrs.Richter. Motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote. Motion to suspend the rules was made by Mr. Sunderhaus, and a second by Mr. Dinkelacker. Motion carried with a 6-0 roll call vote. Motion to adopt was made by Mr.Clark, a second by Mr. Baker and a 6-0 roll call vote.

Resolution 14-23 To Transfer Funds And To Declare An Emergency (Waste Collection Service Fund). Introduced by Mr. Dinkelacker , seconded by Mr. Sunderhaus. Recorded voice vote as 5 Yeas and 1 Nay (Mr.Martin).

Mayor Keller found a typo in the Mayor's Court Receipts for the month of August. The Clerk will correct the error and the report will be reviewed at the next regular council meeting.

Safety Service Director: The electric aggregation contract has been returned. The new rates will show on the October bills. Mr. Braun reminded that work on Robb Avenue will begin on September 8. Traffic on and around Robb Ave. will be rerouted. Duke Energy will be inspecting meters in residents' homes. They have contracted through Southern Cross. All Southern Cross employees will carry ID. Parks & Rec committee needs to meet to discuss Harvest Home pool.

The Law Director had nothing to report.


Since the last council meeting, there had been two Property Maintenance Violations.
