Resolution 16-21 The Approve The Retention Of Dinsmore & Shohl, LLP As Counsel For The City Of Cheviot Community Improvement Corporation. Motion to introduce made by Mr. Martin, second by Mrs. Richter. Adopted with a 7-0 voice vote.

Resolution 16-22 The Authorize The Mayor To Renegotiate Certain Portions Of The Collective Bargaining Agreement With The Cheviot Professional Firefighters. Introduced by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mr. Tiettmeyer.

Mayor's Report: There is no funding available for Westwood Northern Boulevard this year. Increased hours in the Building Department will begin in October.




