Law Director: The Morebattle deed is a work in progress. Mr. Waters needs information from council so that he can prepare legislation for the repeal of the street levy. Legislation for increase in court costs is nearly complete. With regard to codifying the rules and regulations for Harvest Home Park usage, Mr. Waters advises that a comprehensive ordinance be drafted to encompass all rules and regulations to enable easier enforcement.

Mayor's Court Receipts from August 2015 were received and filed with a motion by Mrs. Zech a second by Mrs. Roden and a 7-0 voice vote.


