At the law director's recommendation, Mr. Baker motioned to extend the temporary food truck license for Wake and Bake through October 31. Mr. Waters will have the legislation completed by the October 7 council meeting.

Mary Beth Doyle, a nursing instructor from Xavier University, brought a team of nursing students to observe our meeting tonight. We appreciate their comments and questions.


One property maintenance violation was received.
