President Slaughter called the council meeting to order at 7:30 with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer. The following were found to be in attendance:

Mrs. Zech's absence was excused with a motion by Mr. Sunderhaus, a second by Mrs. Richter and a 6-0 voice vote.

Minutes from the October 4 meeting were approved with a motion by Mr. Tiettmeyer, a second by Mrs Richter, and a 6-0 voice vote.

President Slaughter read the report from Fire Chief Klein into record. The full report is available from the Clerk, and will be posted on the website within the next day or so.

Ken Henry, Joe Williams and Dave Nienaber were in attendance to present a donation to the Fire Department from the Cheviot Firemen's Association. Since Chief Klein was unable to attend the meeting, Kevin Gannon accepted the donation on behalf of the Fire Department. The funds will be used to purchase 3 sets of body armor.

Resolution 16-27 To Authorize The Mayor To Make Specified Changes To The Collective Bargaining Agreement Between The City Of Cheviot And The Cheviot Professional Firefighters. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mr. Clark and approved with a 6-0 voice vote.

Resolution 16-28 To Authorize The Expenditure Of Moneys From The Criminal Activity/Forfeiture Account For The Purchase Of A New Police Cruiser. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mr. Clark and approved with a 6-0 voice vote.

There was a third piece of legislation concerning the "bagging of the meters" for the month of December, but it was determined that the language of the ordinance needed to be tweaked. Tonight's reading by Mr. Waters was considered the first of three readings.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller had no report

Safety Services Director: Mr. Braun advised that sidewalk replacement bills are going out now. Payment is due by November 30. If payment is not received, the amount due will be added to the homeowners tax bill. SCIP preliminary number was received (For Westwood Northern Blvd). More on this at the next meeting. The electric aggregation has saved \$171,000 so far this year.


Law Director: Mr. Waters reported Sam Cecil's Workers Compensation case has been continued until 11/15/16.


