

**Special Cheviot City Council Meeting, July 30, 2014 7PM**

Meeting was opened by President Slaughter at 7pm. The following members were present: Jim Martin, Dennis Dinkelacker, Jim Sunderhaus, Bill Clark, Kitty Zech, Jeff Baker.

There was a motion to dispense with normal procedure made by Mr. Sunderhaus with a second by Mr. Baker. That motion carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

There was discussion about surveys to be conducted at Harvest Home whereby people who use the park will be asked to answer some questions about the facility. Mrs. Zech and Safety-Services Director Tom Braun will be conducting the surveys.

There was also some discussion about council members being able to receive and process internal emails in a timely fashion. Site Mail is part of the problem. President Slaughter will address the issue with Mike Murray.

The main reason for tonight's meeting is to vote on two pieces of legislation to put the tax levy renewals on the November ballot. There is a deadline to submit requests to the Hamilton County Board of Elections, and if these issues are held until Council's next meeting, the deadline will have passed.



Introduced by Mr. Dinkelacker with a second by Mr. Sunderhaus. Adopted with a 6-0 voice vote.

There was brief discussion about the arts and music fest to be held in October, the need for volunteers.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:21 with a motion by Mrs. Zech, a second by Mr. Dinkelacker and a 6-0 voice vote.
