Division of Fire Report 1st Quarter Report 2017

Members of Council,

During the first quarter of 2017 the Fire Department responded to 403 EMS runs and 90 fire runs. Our Fire Inspectors completed 61 fire inspections. Seven fire prevention activities were held at the station. The department installed 19 car seats and trained 180 hours in fire and EMS. Three business Permits have been issued; 3505 Harrison Kre8tive Hands, 3612 Glenmore Floyd Scott CPS, and 3734 Glenmore Family Sewing.

In the first quarter, we have been servicing all our mechanical equipment. (saws, fans, breathing air compressor, extrication tools, and SCBA's)

The Fire Department researched, set up, and conducted a Promotional Assessment Center for Captain and Lieutenant saving the city approximately \$9,000 dollars. We also researched, set up, and conducted an entry level examination in which we charged a fee that covered most of the expenses for administering the test.

Captain Cole Retired in March, David Miller was promoted to Captain, Matt Beahr was promoted to Lieutenant, and one of our part-time employees was number one on the entry level test and was sworn in April 7th. We are now back to full staffing.

The Fire Department now has 4 Ballistic Vests, and Kevlar Helmets to protect our personnel from threats from active shooters, unsafe crime scenes, domestic disputes and runs that involve weapons etc. These were purchased through donations received by the Cheviot Fire Association and Norfolk Southern thanks to Dave Goedle.

We have also purchased (2) cutting edge technology SCBA masks that have integrated thermal imaging cameras in the mask. We are the only Department in the area using this technology purchased partly with donation money.
