Division of Fire Report
3rd Quarter Report 2017

Members of Council,

During the first three quarters of 2017 the Fire Department responded to 1157 EMS runs and 293 fire runs. Our Fire Inspectors completed 175 fire inspections, 31 fire prevention actives were held in the city. The department installed 76 car seats and trained 810 hours in fire and EMS. Fire hydrants are being winterized. All hoses have been tested. Yearly ladder tests have been completed, and annual pump tests are being done this week.

The Fire Department is at full staffing (8) full time (25) part time employees We completed a yearly service on our extrication tools. We have replaced (7) set of expired turnout gear, and (9) expired air bottles. The department also replaced one of the obsolete heart monitor. We will need to start thinking about replacing our 2006 ambulance soon. We spent approximately \$6,000.00 in repairs over the last year. We need to get back on a replacement schedule.

The Fire Department maintains most of our own vehicles and equipment. Weekly checks are done on all vehicles, breathing apparatus, saws, smoke ejectors, and extrication equipment. Daily checks are done on both squads, and fire apparatus. The personnel clean and disinfect the firehouse daily. The fire department also maintains the fuel log for city hall and measures the fuel levels daily.
