## Cheviot may be a small town. But it's got a big heart when it comes to encouraging sports, play, and fellowship.

The Cheviot Fieldhouse, built in 1935, was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2009. It is a building for the people of Cheviot. The Fieldhouse has basketball and volleyball facilities and accommodates community and sporting events, along with the weekly Senior Citizens meeting. Both the upper and lower levels can be rented. Food service facilities are available.

Several schools use the athletic fields behind the Fieldhouse for baseball, softball, football, and soccer. The newly renovated stadium can hold up to 500 sports fans.

For special events, the Mayor's Pavilion with covered picnic-style seating for up to 100 can be rented.

The Cheviot Public Library shares the entrance to Cheviot's 10-acre Fieldhouse Park. A 1-mile walking route takes you on a scenic neighborhood tour where you'll travel past the historic Saint Martin of Tours Church.

Behind the Cheviot Public Library is a newly refurbished playground along with picnic seating. The adjacent paved hopscotch court keeps the kids moving.

The Cincinnati Reds Homefield Make-Over along with P&G's selection of Cheviot for their Community Service Day in 2012, resulted in great improvements to the Fieldhouse, ball fields, stadium, and playground areas.

Our 3 tennis courts underwent major renovations in 2014 and are now ready for action.
