

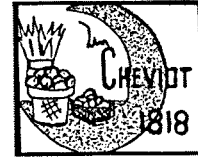

Re: Police Department Activity Report

During the 2nd quarter of 2020, The Cheviot Police Department activity included but not limited to the following:

Our department received 1395 calls for service in the 2nd quarter from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 486 self- initiated / non billed details for a total of 1881 responses for service. Officers made a total of 4730 entries, for the 2nd quarter, into our Pamet/Sundance reporting system. Including the listed dispatches, these entries represent extra jobs, building checks, vacation checks, business checks, directed patrol etc.

### **Miscellaneous Detail information:**

- Fifty (50) details requesting assistance to other jurisdictions
- Eleven (11) overdoses
- Seventeen (17) Dispatched Burglaries and Breaking& Entering
- Fifty-Four (54) Auto Accidents
- Forty- One (41) Dispatched Thefts and Reports
- Seventeen (17) Lock out assists

**Correspondence(s) received:**

Officers Bittner and Reinshagen received a letter of commendation from the Cheviot Fire Dept. Their starting of CPR and assistance when Medics arrived helped to save the life of a Cheviot resident. Channel 12 aired a story on the event.

**Training:**

Many of our officers scheduled training has been canceled due to Coronavirus concerns. It is unclear when or if those trainings will be rescheduled.

Officers are still utilizing online training as practiced in the past.

**Note:**

The application date for the Full -Time eligibility list has closed. The test is scheduled for July 25, 2020.

We have begun utilizing our Sundance RMS beginning June 8, 2020. We have now merged information from our old system into Sundance.
